### **Curriculum Vitae Dr. Kirsten Kappert-Gonther (MP)**

Kirsten Kappert-Gonther has been a Member of the German Parliament since September 2017. As a member of the Green Parliamentary Group, she serves as a spokesperson for health promotion as well as spokesperson for drug policy. From 2011 until 2017, Kirsten Kappert-Gonther was a Member of the Bremische Bürgerschaft (Federal State Parliament of Bremen). In this context, she served as a spokesperson for health-, religious- and cultural policies of the Green Parliamentary Group. In 2015, she was also appointed deputy chairwoman of the fraction. Kirsten Kappert-Gonther has been a member of Alliance 90/The Greens since 2002.

Kirsten Kappert-Gonther holds a doctorate in human medicine and is a medical specialist in psychiatry and psychotherapy. In 1999, she became the head of a rehabilitation facility for mentally ill people. From 2002 until 2005, she established an outpatient clinic and also assumed guiding tasks. In 2005, Kirsten Kappert-Gonther opened her own practice for psychotherapy. Before accepting her first mandate in the Bremische Bürgerschaft, she held classes in psychiatry and psychotherapy at the Ottersberg University of Applied Sciences.

Kirsten Kappert-Gonther was born in 1966 in Marburg and is married with two adult children. She lives in Berlin and Bremen.
